We are seeking an experienced youth pastor who has passion and expertise for delivering pastoral care and discipleship for the 11-18 age range to join and coordinate a team of committed volunteers.

The successful applicant will have proven experience of working in a pastoral context within a church or community groups in a paid or voluntary capacity in previous roles.

Main Responsibilities

- 1. To oversee and develop work with young people in a consultative process within the church and the local community
- 2. To help young people to explore the Christian faith in a creative and dynamic way and to enable: spiritual understanding and growth intergenerational engagement participation midweek after school worship
- 3. To consult with children and young people and in partnership identify their needs and provide a range of social and spiritual education and some intergenerational activities, including worship, which aim to meet these needs
- 4. To co-ordinate the work of the Friday night youth group
- 5. To pastorally support the young people and their wider families
- 6. To network with local voluntary and statutory children and youth providers to build working partnerships which respond to children and young people's needs and to explore ecumenically the provision of schools' work
- 7. To develop a sustainable, age-appropriate social media presence
- 8. To recruit, motivate and train volunteer youth workers following Safer Recruitment practice
- 9. To manage and administer an agreed budget to enable the ministry with children and young people to develop
- 10. To undertake any other related duties, identified by the line manager and minister as are within your capabilities and level of responsibility, in order to meet the needs of the work with children and young people
